## STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different directors (because prices can vary).

<b>ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)</b>	<b>£ 2515</b>
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event, or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements.	<b>£1265</b>
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care during office hours.	<b>£150</b>
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's mortuary and then at the arranging branch premises.	<b>£300</b>
Providing a suitable coffin – Simple Veneered Oak	<b>£450</b>
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (Where viewing is requested by the customer)	<b>FOC</b>
At a time and date, you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or another appropriate vehicle	<b>£350</b>

<b>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</b>	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event, or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
<b>Burial (funeral director's charges only)</b>	<b>£1250</b>
<b>Cremation (funeral director's charges only)</b>	<b>£1100</b>

<b>FEES YOU MUST PAY</b>	
For an Attended or Unattended burial Fee, the burial fee	<b>POA</b>
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local resident is:	<b>POA</b>
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot: for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
For an Attended Cremation funeral, the cremation fee	<b>£995</b>
In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for residents is:	<b>£995</b>

<b>ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES</b>	
This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:	
Additional mileage outside 15 miles (price per mile)	<b>£2.00</b>
Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc.) (price per transfer during office hours)	<b>On Request</b>
Collection of ashes, returned to the arranging branch	<b>£100</b>
Embalming	<b>£150</b>
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister or religion etc.)	<b>POA</b>
Services supplied outside of normal hours	<b>Not offered</b>
The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.
